DIRECTOR S ORDER

The Director, of the Gaseous Fuels Regulation, *Technical Standards and Safety Act, 2000*, S.O. 2000, c. 16, pursuant to his authority as provided for in Section 36 (3) (c) of the *Technical Standards and Safety Act, 2000*, hereby orders the following:

- 1. Effective immediately Ontario Regulation 212/01 (being the Ontario Regulation made under the *Technical Standards and Safety Act, 2000* for Gaseous Fuels) is hereby varied as follows:
 - i) In Section 4 (1) the reference to Where this Regulation requires the approval of an appliance or any equipment of thing, no person shall is replaced with No person shall.
 - ii) Section 14 is amended by adding the following subsection:

(6) A distributor who is advised of an unacceptable condition in accordance with this section, shall if the condition is not corrected in the time provided, shut off gas to the appliance, equipment or work.
