Training & Certification Regulations
Propane Powered Lift Truck Cylinder Exchange

Section 32(1), (5) of Ontario Regulation 348/86, as amended, requires that persons exchanging propane cylinders on propane fueled equipment be trained to a standard accepted by TSSA and have a record of that training.

Based on the Ministry of Labour "Guidelines for the Safe Operation and Maintenance of Powered Lift Trucks", coupled with the CSA International Standard B335-94 entitled "Industrial Lift Truck Operator Training", we have concluded that training, consistent with the Ministry of Labour guidelines meets the intent of Section 12 of the *Energy Act*.

The TSSA requirement for a specific Record of Training (ROT) for exchanging cylinders on propane powered lift trucks, scissors lifts, person lifts, ice-resurfacers, floor sweepers and polishers is suspended.

This Bulletin replaces Bulletin PR01/1 dated January 16, 2001 effective immediately.
