External Emergency Response Procedures



In accordance with O. Reg 211/01 the following External Emergency Response and Preparedness Procedures are in place at the Air Liquide propane facility regarding response outside the property and to ensure safety for the surrounding public.

In case of a fire or release incident, Air Liquide personnel have been instructed to follow emergency shutdown procedures and evacuate. As soon as the staff have evacuated the area they are to contact emergency services (911) and provide them with the address and details of the incident. When the Cambridge Fire Department arrive, they will continue the evacuation process of nearby public receptors, if deemed necessary by the Fire Department. Air Liquide staff will offer advice and assistance to the emergency responders if requested.
