



Labour Mobility Certification Process for Operating Engineers/Operators

What is labour mobility? Labour mobility allows an individual certified for a specific occupation in one province or territory to be recognized for the same or matched certification in another province or territory without additional material training, experience, examinations or assessments. Encouraging recognition of matched certification across Canada benefits both workers and employers alike.

Matched Certificates / Non-Matched Equivalency

If certification from another jurisdiction has been deemed a match in the province of Ontario, TSSA will request that applicants follow the checklist detailed in the mandatory steps below:

- 1) Submit request through [Client Portal](#), under the Applications section, select Examination Booking. Follows the steps to submit.
- 2) Attach with the submission proof of valid and current standardized certification issued by a matched jurisdiction or regulatory authority.
 - A colour copy of the standardized certificate must be submitted with the application.
- 3) Fees (certification, examination and assessment) as per the [Fee Schedule](#).

Applicants who follow the above procedure can expect a response from TSSA within 15 business days.
